

The below General Terms represent an integral part of the arrangement between the OpenBlend Society (the event Organiser) and the applicant for the OpenBlend Conference.

General Terms apply to all attendees of the Conference, organised and implemented by the OpenBlend Society. They are accepted by the applicant by their act of registering for the Conference.

The arrangement is effective as soon as the electronic application form is filled in and either submitted via the [www.openblend.org](http://www.openblend.org) web page or sent to [prijava@openblend.org](mailto:prijava@openblend.org) via e-mail.

Each applicant is notified after submitting the application, via e-mail, and if so indicated, via mail, that their application has been accepted.

Registration fee includes: attending the presentations, servings of coffee and other refreshments during the breaks, lunch, and attending the cocktail party following the event. The reduced registration fee amounts to 160€ and is available up to and including 9<sup>th</sup> September 2011. The full registration fee for applications submitted after 9<sup>th</sup> September 2011 amounts to 200€.

Final application submission date is 14<sup>th</sup> September 2011.

The obligation of the applicant towards payment is effective immediately as the application is submitted, with the notable exception of the application being cancelled in full concert and prior arrangement with the Organiser at least five working days prior to the Conference.

The applicant must pay the registration fee at most eight days after an invoice was issued and sent to them by mail, or at most eight days after the Conference took place in the case they have not yet received the invoice by the day of the Conference.

In the case of justified absence (illness, accident, family death, force Majeure) announced at least three days before the Conference, the Organiser will refund the applicant in full, without interest.

The Organiser will keep 80% of the registration fee as a compensation for the cost of organising if the registration is cancelled due to special causes after the above deadlines have passed. The remaining fee will be refunded to the applicant.

The Organiser will keep 30% of the registration fee for all other cancellations up to and including 15<sup>th</sup> August 2011. The Organiser will keep 70% of the registration fee for all other cancellations between 16<sup>th</sup> August and 7<sup>th</sup> September 2011. There will be no refunds for cancellations after 8<sup>th</sup> September 2011.

Together with their announcement of absence, the applicant must submit a written explanation of the reasons for their absence. The Organiser will not refund the registration fee in case of a missing explanation.

In the case of a timely and valid cancellation, an according credit will be issued to the applicant if their registration fee is still outstanding, the remaining debt pending eight days' notice after the credit has been issued.

The Organiser will not refund the registration fee if the applicant does not attend the Conference without notice or leaves the Conference early due to any reason.

The organiser withholds the right to charge the applicant with legitimate default interest in the case

of delayed payments.

The Organiser will not refund the registration fee in any other case (including but not limited to, termination of attendance upon request by the Organiser, due to severe violation of either house Rules or other regulations).

The Organiser will not be held liable for any alienation and/or loss of personal property.

In the event of insufficient attendance and/or force Majeure, the Organiser withholds the right to cancel or reschedule the Conference. In the case of cancellation of the Conference, the arrangement is thereby terminated and the Organiser will refund the registration fee in full, without interest, to the applicant.

The Organiser withholds the right to change these General Terms at their discretion.
